Nursery (ages 0-3)



We provide a stimulating environment for the smallest of our Sunday attendees with a wonderful playground designed for young people, warm and caring teachers and a wireless parent notification system in the event that little ones cannot be soothed by anyone but their parents.

On Sundays, parents need to complete a registration form on each of their children. Each child is to be signed in for attendance tracking in the foyer before church and then signed out at the cottage when church is over. Upon signing in on our attendance roster, each child shall receive a white name tag, to be worn throughout the morning. Every volunteer working with children's church or youth group has a background check run on them, regardless of any relationship with any child.

WELCOME TO OUR CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

The children and youth of our Center are very important to us. We offer four programs during our 10:30 AM Sunday Services, a nursery for young ones and three more groups, based on age, all designed to share spiritual ideas in a loving and supportive environment. Our focus is often on non-traditional learning using the resources of our Center site and the creek that runs through it as well as field trips to various local sites to help share spiritual concepts. The programs are under the direction of Diana Johnson and her staff of marvelous, volunteer teachers.

Children's Church

Little Lights (ages 4-6)



Lessons and activities for this age group are centered on experiential learning. We often involve the children with art, games, music and outdoor activities while

conveying the spiritual basics of love, kindness, compassion and empowerment. Because we run an active program, we encourage parents to consider bring their children in casual clothing. We love having parent and grandparent volunteers as extra hands for this wonderful group.

They certainly do not want to spend a perfectly great Sunday morning listening to someone talk! We build more complex spiritual concepts with this group with an emphasis on preparing them for the transition into their teen years and participation in our youth group.

“Source” Youth Group (ages 13-18)

The teen years are a time of incredible spiritual interest and development. Our youth group meets on Sunday afternoons from 1-3 PM in the Center’s LightSource Village. A dedicated duo of volunteer advisors, James Massengale and Jamie Weil, guide the teens. Each meeting includes a time of personal sharing, a workshop based on a spiritual principle, and a business meeting run by the teens themselves.

The teens travel to two camps, one three-day camp in the winter, and a weeklong camp in the summer. Throughout the year they participate in fundraising efforts to attend camp and joint gatherings of local youth groups in the North State. Our teens consistently report that youth group makes a tremendous impact on their lives!
